CREATIVE WRITING CLUB 2017-2019

Creative writing is more than fun. It is an important life skill. On 4th July 2017, Depts. of English and Functional English inaugurated a workshop on Creative Writing among Students. The sessions were decided to be conducted on alternate months that are likely meant for encouraging aspiring writers. Creative Writing Club is open to all students interested in poetry, prose, plays and short story. The purpose of creative writing club is to provide a positive and productive atmosphere for budding student writers and to help them learn and grow. During the course of the year, the Creative Writing Club promoted writing through contests and giving away opportunities of publication and multiple writing tips.

2017-2018

On 2nd August 2017, Poetry Workshop was organized. The motive behind this workshop is that the writers will learn to be better writers by working along with other established writers who are engaged in similar efforts and goals. This workshop is for anyone afflicted with an insatiable urge to write poems. The students were made to sit in different groups and made to write poems on particular themes. The theme was "Memories." The students were expected to read poetries aloud. And other students were asked to analyse the being read. After analyzing the session, the poet was asked to elaborate on the their inspiration to write poem.



On 4th October 2017, Prose workshop was conducted on the theme "Freedom." The students were taught the detailed ways and areas of focus such as character building, plot, timeline, setting and narration on how to write a prose. The students submitted their works and the best works were put on the notice board.



On 6th December 2017, workshop on drama was conducted based on the theme 'Adventure.' The students were divided into four groups. The students were guided by Ms. Julie Dominic, HOD on how to write scripts for drama. The students wrote the script for their plays and the best play was performed in the auditorium during Literary Fest.



On 14th February 2018, a short story competition was held for the whole college on the topic "Love." Interested students were allowed to take part in the contest. Around 60 students were there, and the best five were awarded.

2018-2019

On 7th August, 2018 a small inauguration function of club was conducted in order to introduce the club to the freshers. The various programme included were word quest, comic strips, story extension, relay story competition. We conducted a game 'Word Quest.' The purpose of the game was to make the students familiarize new worlds from dictionary. In this game, the meaning of a particular word is given to students as clue and they were made to guess the answer. The game was very informative and innovative for students and they were excited to learn new words.



On 9th October 2018, a workshop on comic strips was conducted on the theme Political Scenario.
